



Billings has a large number of parks that the whole family can enjoy. One of the favorite spots on a hot summer day is **Rose Park** with swimming and wading pool, water slides and picnic area. One of the oldest parks, **Pioneer Park**, offers a disc golf course and **Amend Park** accommodates ball fields for football, soccer and rugby.



Billings only wildlife park, **ZooMontana**, is nestled in 70 acres of lush Montana green along Canyon Creek. A native trail winds among native and exotic animals in their natural habitat. One of the favorites is Bruno the grizzly bear, but you can also see bighorn sheep, a Siberian tiger, red pandas, river otters, wolves, eagles, a children's barnyard zoo, a sensory garden and more.
