WHY REGISTER YOUR BICYCLE ?

Registering your bike will assist local law enforcement in identifying your bicycle in the event that it is lost or stolen. Local pawnshops enter information about items that are pawned – this is then sent to the Billings Police Department.

HOW TO REGISTER YOUR BICYCLE:

It's free – and it's painless. Just go to the following location and fill out a registration form:

You will receive – or be mailed - a numbered decal that is to be placed on your bike.

The number will be kept on file at the Police Department. In the event that your bike is lost or stolen, the Police will be able to identify your bike from this number and return your bike to you.

This service is free of charge.

The Billings Police Department recommends that you place the decal on a visible part of your bike, such as below the seat on the frame of the bicycle.
