



2007 Heart & Sole Run

This year the 28th Annual Heart & Sole Run took place on Saturday, June 9th at 8:30 a.m. at Grandview Park, N. 30th and Poly Drive, north of St. Vincent Healthcare. There was a 5K, 10K, 2 Mile Health Walk and ½ Mile Stroll, which gave all 1,135 participants an event that fit their abilities.

It took 170 volunteers from St. Vincent Healthcare, WellsFargo, the Billings Fire Department, and the community to make this a safe event. What was special about this year's event was that during the awards ceremonies, Jim Paquette, President and CEO of St. Vincent Healthcare, presented a check for \$10,000 to Mayor Ron Tussing for trail projects and specifically for the matching dollars for the corridor connecting the MetraPark portion of the Dutcher Trail with and including the Main Street Underpass.

Over the past two years, a portion of the Heart & Sole Race Proceeds have been designated to support The Heritage Trail, The Greater Billings non-motorized trail system, providing opportunities for multipurpose community recreation. The Trails in the Billings' community will benefit greatly from this gift from the St. Vincent Healthcare Heart & Sole Run.
